Travel time can increase significantly during the summer months due to busy traffic on the A47.

The ground-floor features an open-plan layout with the kitchen being the only room separated by a door from the living and dining area. Additional amenities include a porch, conservatory, and garage.

Upstairs, there are three bedrooms: two doubles and one small single. The bathroom includes a shower-overbath. Stairs lead directly from the living area with no wall or door for separation.

The front and rear gardens are gravelled with a few shrubs, and the wooden decking seen in photos has been removed. A driveway is also available.
