# Welcome to our supported living home in Doncaster.

#### **About this home**

We're delighted to showcase our new development of ten single-occupancy self-contained supported living bungalows (five detached and five semi-detached/terraced) in the Mexborough area of Doncaster.

The impressive development comprises ten single-occupation, self-contained bungalows. Three of the homes will have an altered layout to provide one large bedroom and a large wet room; the remaining homes will all have two bedrooms and a shared bathroom.

The homes will support ten adults. Each person supported has their own individualised bungalow adapted to meet their needs, along with a dedicated core support team.

#### Life at the home

This supported living home offers a therapeutic environment where people can develop their skills and reach their potential. The therapeutic offer includes: adapted Dialectical Behaviour Therapy (DBT)which teaches coping skills and alternatives

to self-harm and self-injurious behaviour; Positive Behaviour Support; Intensive Interaction, Sensory Rooms, and Gardens. In addition to the therapeutic interventions, everyone will be supported and encouraged to access the local community and develop a full and enriched life.

#### Who would be suited to this home?

This supported living home offers specialist support for adults with autism spectrum conditions, ABI, behaviours that may challenge, complex health needs, complex needs, deafblindness, deafness, dementia, emotional needs, epilepsy, hearing impairments, learning disabilities, mental health, mild learning disabilities, moderate learning disabilities, PMLD, restricted mobility, severe learning disabilities, sight impairment. Each person supported has a dedicated core team trained to support their physical and mental health needs. The team comprises a Registered Manager, Deputy, Practice Leads, Specialist Support Workers and DBT Practitioners.
