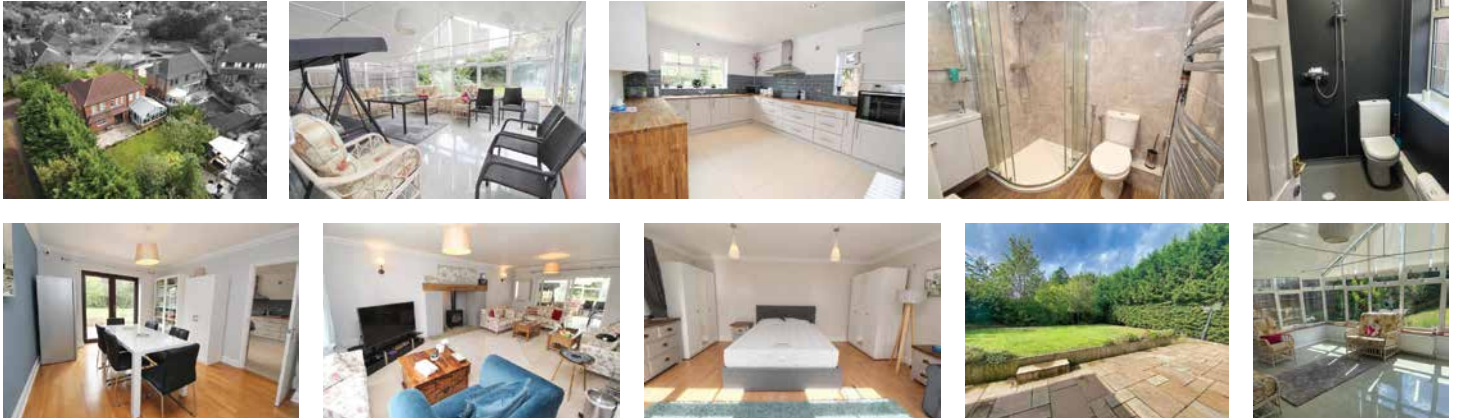
Life at the home
